Antonio M. Romanucci, a partner in Romanucci & Blandin LLC, is spearheading a fundraising effort to benefit a veterans internship program at the Midwest Brain Injury Clubhouse.

The Adopt-a-Veteran fundraiser will be held March 18 from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. at the non-profit organization's facility at 300 N. Elizabeth St., Suite 310-C, Chicago.

The Midwest Brain Injury Clubhouse, which provides post-acute care to traumatically brain-injured patients, offers paid internships at the clubhouse to military veterans who have sustained a mild traumatic brain injury or experience post-concussive syndrome — to assist them in transitioning from therapy to competitive employment.

Romanucci, whose firm concentrates on representing victims with traumatic brain injuries, helped found the clubhouse and served as its board president for seven years.
